- 2) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar tests accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET preferred.
- 3) Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% of the marks (50% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST) or equivalent grade wherever grading system is practiced at the Master's degree level (M.SC/MA in YOGA/SAMSKRIT with PG-DIPLOMA in YOGA) in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- 4) Distinguished and eminent having acquired high repute for propagation and disseminating the Sanskrit knowledge.

## 2.YOGA THEARAPY and COUNSELLING-01 POST (FULL TIME)
