1. Title of the Best Practice

Conducting programmes to create awareness and educate general public about Samskrit language and literature.

- Conducting Spoken Samskrit and Sarala manaka samskritam courses – FUNCTIONal Sanskrit-
- Conducting Samskrit
- Conducting competitions for school and college students
- Encouraging homemakers to study regular Samskrit programmes and explore new employment opportunities MA students show age and gender
- Empowering women by shastric training

Objectives of the Practice

There is a wide spread perception among general public that Samskrit represents only religious and spiritual content. The objective of the programme is to,

- Help students to become self-sufficient in spoken Samskrit language skills.
- Expose the diversity present in Samskrit language and literature and provide avenues for de-stressing and engaging in learning Samskrit kavyas and dramas.
- Attracting school and college students to pursue higher education in Samskrit through competitions.
- Providing opportunities to homemakers who have discontinued studies due to domestic commitments to study further and fulfill their unfulfilled ambitions.
- Coping with modern stressful lifestyles by teaching value-based Samskrit texts such Yoga, Counselling etc.

2. The Context

Women often choose to discontinue studies and work to care for family and children after marriage. They find it difficult to get back to active workforce after a sabbatical. KSU offers options to such women who are keen to pursue their studies and create new employment opportunities for themselves through Samskrit teaching.

Bangalore being the IT hub, courses such as Panchatantatra, Bhagavad Gita, Hitopadesha will help employees cope with stressful situations and work and home and safeguard their mental health.

3. Practice:

- There is no limitation on age for admission to the courses offered by KSU.
- Online short-term courses and workshops for wider reach.
- Bridge courses and training programmes to enable students who are getting back to studies after a long gap.

4. The evidence of Success:

The evidence of success is in the following factors:

- Number of women students have increased in all courses.
- Teaching and learning medium is Samskrit and student are able to adapt to the medium effortlessly.
- Approximately 60% of students who are enrolled in higher studies (postgraduate and PhD) have been previous students of the University.
- Increase in number of schools and colleges who are participating in Samskrit competitions and Samskrit week celebrations. Show an increase in list of participants of students last 5 yrs

5. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

- Diversity of the students (in respect of age, background etc.) creates problems in scheduling course timings and duration.
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- Teachers find it difficult to invest adequate time for offering more courses and teaching and training general public.

Resources required:

- More teachers need to be appointed
- More funds to be allocated
